

Apostille

In 1978, Israel signed and ratified the Hague Convention Abolishing the Requirement of Legalization for Foreign Public Documents - 1961 (hereinafter: the Hague Convention).

The purpose of this Convention was to shorten the processes required for a particular country to recognize the official documents issued by another country by means of Apostille certification.

Public documents and certificates that were issued in one of the countries that are signatories to the above Convention and which bear the Apostille stamp are valid for presentation in Israel without the need for additional verification/certification by the diplomatic/consular representative at the Israeli mission.
